



# HIGH HOLIDAY YOUTH PROGRAMMING

For BBRS students, day school students, grandchildren

Programs for **youth in kindergarten through 7th grades** will take place on both days of Rosh Hashanah from 10:30 am to 12:15 pm and on Yom Kippur from 10:45 am to 1:00 pm. Programming will be a combination of youth services, learning activities on themes of the day, and time for games and snacks (no snack will be served on Yom Kippur). All children must wear masks. Youth services will be held outside in a tent; other programs will be in classrooms.

**Teens in 8th through 12th grades** will have an open Youth Lounge during the morning with an interactive exploration of High Holiday themes from 11:00 am to 12:00 pm on Rosh Hashanah and from 11:15 am to 12:15 pm on Yom Kippur. All teens must wear masks. They are welcome to help with other youth programming; contact Rabbi Julie if interested.

The Young Family Service, geared towards **families with babies through preK children**, will run from 9:15 to 10:15 am each day of Rosh Hashanah and from 9:30 to 10:30 am on Yom Kippur. It will be held outside in a tent; adults must wear masks -- children 2 and over are encouraged to wear masks.

There will be a **Yaldeinu service for special needs families** from 11:15 am to 12:15 pm on Rosh Hashanah Day 1 and from 12:00 to 1:00 pm on Yom Kippur. Services will be outside in a tent; all must wear masks.
