
A New Prayer Book for a New Generation



The adoption of a new *siddur* and *mahzor* is truly a momentous occasion and will offer us all an enriched and shared tool for accessing our Jewish prayer experience as a community.

Get to Know Siddur Lev Shalem

We will officially inaugurate the Lev
Shalem Siddur during Shabbat services on
Saturday morning, June 4. This is the
Shabbat just before Shavuot,
commemorating the giving of the Torah
to the Jewish people at Mt. Sinai.

In the months leading up to Shavuot, we will transition to using the new siddur in the sanctuary using advance copies. We will also be hosting a number of programs for all of us to become familiar with the new prayer book, including morning and evening sessions with Rabbi Isenberg and Cantor Wallach plus special Shabbatot dedicated to learning more about our new prayer book.



Dedicate a Lasting Memory


