

Israel is at war.

This war is multifaceted and includes sophisticated propaganda efforts from enemies of Israel, propaganda efforts that rely on biased media. An example of these propaganda efforts is what happened when a misfied PIJ (Palestinian Islamic Jihad - the Palestinian group most closely associated with Iran) rocket hit the grounds of the Baptist hospital in Gaza City.
