She is the former department chief of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Overlook Hospital and the former director of the Fertility Center at Columbia University, and a trailblazer in the delivery of IVF services to women from the inception of this treatment. A longstanding member of CBI, Dr. Margulis will draw on her decades of experience, beginning prior to the legalization of abortion, to discuss what constitutes women's reproductive healthcare, from in vitro fertilization to pregnancy termination, and how the overturning of Roe poses a threat to it all.
